

HIGHER CERTIFICATE IN HUMAN RESOURCE PRACTICES

The Independent Institute of Education (The IIE)

Human Resource Courses educate and qualify students to take up entry-level positions in human resource and payroll administration related jobs. The IIE Higher Certificate in Human Resource Practices aims to provide students with the knowledge and skills needed to administer and conduct various human resource functions including payroll administration, which meets the requirement of the relevant legal and statutory requirements.

What is this Higher Certificate's accreditation status?

This higher certificate is accredited by the Council of Higher Education (CHE) and is registered by the South African Qualifications Authority on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) as a 120-credit qualification on Level 5 (SAQA ID No: 91728).

Who is this Higher Certificate aimed at?

Distance study is ideal for working adults who prefer not to attend full-time lectures but still want to achieve a focus on Human Resource Practices in the business environment.





What are the benefits of distance study?

The distance delivery mode provides the student with the opportunity to study in the comfort of their home and to plan their study workload according to their individual pace. The support offered online and through other means ensures that the student is not left feeling alone in this process and can still enjoy high quality support throughout their learning journey.

Students who successfully completed the Higher Certificate in Business Principles and Practice have the option to register for the IIE Bachelor of Commerce degree programmes. Academic credit for some modules into the degree may be given. On completion of this Higher Certificate, students can continue into The IIE degree with credits being transferred from certain of the HCBPP modules. Note: a minimum pass of between 60% and 65% in Accounting 1A and Business Communication C is required for credit awarded into the relevant degree.

What is The Teaching and Learning Strategy of The IIE's Varsity College, and how will it help prepare me for the 21st century working world?

At The IIE's Varsity College we are proud of and passionate about our shift away from the 'traditional lecturing' methodology to our blended-learning strategy – the VCBlend.

How is this Higher Certificate structured at The IIE's Varsity College?

Informed by the principle of flexibility, a selection of modules will be offered each semester to accommodate a study journey to suit the personal needs of the student within the qualification progression rules.

The curriculum below is correct at the time of print. Please note that in line with academic practice, The IIE's curriculum is reviewed annually thus changes may occur in module structure and sequence in order to ensure that the qualification remains relevant. The exit level outcomes of the programme do not change. Registered students receive an updated programme curriculum on an annual basis.

The IIE Higher Certificate in Human Resources and Practices consists of 10 modules. This is an 24 months part-time programme offered via the distance mode of delivery, please consult your

student advisor for full qualification fee. The modules are presented via a distance mode of delivery, supported by online mediation sessions. Students will be required to complete various forms of assessments and activities, with the final assessments being written in hard copy at the site of registration.

Students will have the option of securing a number of face-to-face support workshops that will be offered by each of The IIE's Varsity College exam centres. These sessions provide the opportunity for rich discussion and conceptual engagement as well as an opportunity to meet fellow students. However, should students opt not to attend any of these support workshops, the learner guide, textbook and online facilitation will provide the necessary support for student success.

Where do I write my exams?

The IIE's Varsity College Exam Centres

Eight IIE Varsity College Campus exam centres are available within South Africa for selection as the exam centre at which you would write exams and receive operational support.

Please note that students studying in the distance mode may opt to attend optional contact workshops. These are only available at The IIE's Varsity College Campus Exam Centres. A Consultant will provide you with the details.

Alternative Venues

An alternative examination centre is only permissible for international students and those located in a province of South Africa where there is no IIE campus. It is your responsibility to identify an examination centre (educational or religious site or embassy or consulate) if you have not already done so. Once you have secured your examination venue, we require a letter confirming availability from the examination centre you have chosen. If a change of examination venue is required – it is again the student's responsibility to locate a new venue and provide the confirmation letter together with the supporting documentation which details the reason for the examination venue change.

Please note, once the examination venue is selected and confirmed, it cannot be changed within eight weeks prior to the summative examination.

INPCf110 Competency Test

At The IIE's Varsity College, we recognise that some students have developed the core skills to succeed in basic computer skills, either through schooling activities, or personal experience. The module Introduction to Personal Computing (INPCf110w) is a 5-credit module and is offered across many of The IIE's academic programmes. We provide students with an opportunity to write a competency test for the Introduction to Personal Computing (INPCf110w) module for 2020 which, if passed, will exempt the student from having to attempt the module and the mark obtained in the competency assessment will become the student's mark for the module.

The competency test will take place prior to the commencement of the module. Students must register for the module in order to access the competency assessment. The test is completed online and will take place in a computer lab on campus. The assessment covers basic Microsoft Windows 10 functionality and Microsoft Office 2016 applications (Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook).

Your results will be available immediately. If you do not pass the competency test you will be required to attend class and complete the module.

NOTE: Students have a MAXIMUM of 3 years in which to complete this qualification

- Curriculum and content are subject to change.
- Students will be required to register per academic year.
- Fees stated are per academic year and not for the full qualification.
- Students who are unsuccessful in a module(s) will need to reregister.

What must I pass in order to graduate with this Higher Certificate?

In order to be awarded this qualification, you must have achieved a minimum final year mark of fifty percent (50%) for each module of the programme and have met all the Work Integrated Learning requirements.
