## **NEW STUDENTS**

- Please read this fee schedule in combination with your chosen qualification fact sheet, as well as your desired minimum completion time, to determine how many modules you intend to register within the academic year.
- An online Bill of Costs calculator is available should you find this easier for the calculation of your fees, accessible at www.varsitycollege.co.za
- A minimum of four modules must be registered within an academic year, to remain within maximum completion timelines.
- Upon acceptance of the offer to study with The IIE, students are required to pay a non-refundable, pre-registration fee of R2 500. This amount will be offset against tuition for 2024 and will automatically be deducted from your first payment at the point of registration.
- Payment must take place at the point of registration via PayU when completing your online registration.
- The full settlement, deposit, or 1st instalment for the 10-month option is due on/before registration.
   Until payment is made, you will not be able to submit your registration.
- Your next payment is due in the month following registration or March, and will be processed based on the debit order date selected.
- · Only Method B and C, allow for Debit orders on the 15th, 25th or last day of the month.
- Please note that should a full-settlement payment plan selected not be adhered to, we reserve the right to adjust this to the 10-month option. The 10-month payment plan is not available for students registering for modules in one semester only.
- Fees are in respect of The Independent Institute of Education's tuition only. Academic material and all other expenses, including off-campus internet access and personal IT requirements, are for the student's account.
- Where students are the recipients of a loan or bursary, account payers are liable for any deficit between fees billed and payment received.
- All students are required to consult the academic information section in the Student Handbook to
  ensure that they meet the admission requirements for their selected qualification. Students may
  be required to register for additional modules or Short Learning Programmes (SLPs) if they do not
  meet the required criteria within the relevant qualification. SLPs may be added to your registration
  automatically by your campus based on relevant admission requirements. This will be at an
  additional cost to all students required to complete SLPs.
- The Postgraduate Certificate in Education in Senior Phase and FET requires students to provide evidence in competence in an African Language and ICT. - Once you have completed your registration and payment has been made, your campus will finalise your registration. During this process you will receive the link to Wizebooks to order your textbooks and on finalisation of your registration, you will receive a confirmation of registration email.
- Students are required to register per academic year. Fees are quoted per academic year and NOT for the full qualification.
- In certain cases, Higher Certificates indicated above provide for an articulation route into Bachelors degrees of other Schools. Please consult your Student Advisor for more information.
- Any academic credit applied for will be charged at R250 per module. Please consult your student advisor on the process to follow when applying for academic credits.
