

Open Day “Win a Bursary” Rules

This promotion is conducted by The IIE’s Varsity College, an educational brand of The Independent Institute of Education (“Varsity College”), and by entering the promotion, you acknowledge that you have read and understand the following terms and conditions:

1. The IIE’s Varsity College is awarding 8 lucky winners bursaries to the value of R35 000 each. The bursary is for full – time contact studies towards a Full – Time Undergraduate Qualification in 2025. To be eligible for this bursary you have to do the following:
 - Attend The IIE Varsity College Open Day event in May 2024.
 - Attend an appointment with a student advisor and complete your application for 2025 studies prior to or during the Open Day with intention to study at The IIE’s Varsity College in 2025.

9. The bursaries may only be used towards tuition fees and this excludes all academic material. If the winners would like to register for qualifications which cost more than R35 000, the winners will be required to pay the shortfall. If the qualification is less than R35 000, the winners will forfeit the difference and The IIE’s Varsity College will not pay out the balance in cash, nor can it be used as payment for any other costs.
